

The official names for the Federation *Humberto Ortega*-class war destroyer are somewhat controversial.

The ships are named for revolutionary leaders from Earth's history, but this naming is done from the point of view of people in the 24th century, looking back and lacking the context of our times. Some of the names in the official NCC-number list (http://www.starfleetgames.com/documents/Fed_NCC_Numbers3.pdf) are men who later became infamous for truly horrible deeds.
