

The official names for the Federation *Ramius*-class FFB battle frigates are all taken from famous captains of submarines. Some are fictional (*Marko Ramius*, from Tom Clancy's "The Hunt for Red October") and some are historical (*Gunter Prien*, *Yahachi Tanabe*; both World War 2 sub captains).

Officially, only four battle frigates were built (*Ramius, Prien, Tanabe, Enright*, and the later FBV prototype *Bryant*), in competition with the *Ortega*-class DW war destroyers. The *Ramius*-class lost that competition and the four ships were sent off to serve their days in the 6th Fleet, with other "oddballs", like the CS strike cruisers.

However, there is no limit to how many FFB ships you can field in *Federation Commander* or *A Call to Arms Star Fleet.*

To assist with keeping the theme of the names, but add more of this class to your fleet, we offer this list of additional fictional submarine captain names: Bart Mancuso (Captain, USS Dallas, "The Hunt for Red October") Nemo/Prince Dakkar (Captain, Nautilus, Jules Verne's "Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea") Harriman Nelson (Admiral, USOS/S.S.R.N. The names you choose for your custom-printed decals are your decision. This list is presented just as food for thought.

One thing some people are not aware of is that, after the first four purpose-built FFB ships, the Federation later used the design as an "upgrade-path" for many of the remaining *Burke*-class frigates, refitting them to the FFB design. This means **any** frigate name (and there are over 100 of them) is completely valid for use on battle frigates as well.
